

# **N.U.B.E. Camp Student Code of Conduct**

## **GENERAL BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS**

While participating in the University of Nebraska-Lincoln College of Engineering N.U.B.E. Camp, you not only represent yourself but also your school and community. There are certain behavioral expectations that must be observed by all participants to maintain participation in the camp.

All participants of N.U.B.E. Camp are prohibited from involvement in unsafe, irresponsible, and/or illegal conduct. In addition, you must abide by the following rules and regulations:

1. I am committed to fully participate in all activities of N.U.B.E. Camp
2. I promise that my attitude, conduct and appearance will be such to reflect credit on my school and community.
3. I will not be in the cabin/sleeping room of a member of the opposite sex. Failure to abide by this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the camp.
4. I will not have in my possession or use drugs, alcohol or tobacco at any time during the camp. Note that all Camp Kitaki facilities are smoke free.

The leaders/staff of N.U.B.E. Camp reserve the right to immediately terminate from the camp, anyone who is found to have violated these behavioral expectations. Students terminated from the camp will be sent home at their own expense and will be responsible for all other expenses associated with their termination. Parent(s)/guardian(s) will be immediately notified of the student's termination.
